QM TECHNICAL COMMITTEE Establishment of a Quartermaster Technical Committee is announced in OQMG OO 40-4A, 14 Dec 43, rescinding OQMG OO 105, 8 May 42, as amended. This committee will effect coordination between the interested arms and services during the development and standardization of types of equipment and the preparation and coordination of specifications. It will also act in an advisory capacity to The Quartermaster General.

BRANCH CHANGES OQMG 00 25-59A, 14 Dec 43, rescinding OQMG 00's 25-58, 11 Dec 43 and 25-59, 11 Dec 43, establishes the Technical Information Branch and the Intelligence Branch in the immediate Office of The Quartermaster General, under the supervision of the Deputy The Quartermaster General for Administration and Management.

DEPOT DISTRIBUTION RESPONSIBILITY OQMG Cir Ltr 84, Supplement No 3, 11 Dec 43

made of responsibility of depots for distribution of Quartermaster supplies
for troops within the continental limits of the United States.
