SUBJECT: Application for Appointment in the Officers' Reserve Corps

Lieutenant Colonel Corydon P. Spruill TO: Tenney Circle Chapel Hill, North Carolina

- You may now apply for appointment in the Officers' Reserve Corps for an initial five-year period in the appropriate section and in the highest grade held at the time of relief from active duty. Inclosed is a copy of current War Department Circular No. 194, dated 28 June 1945, concerning appointments in the Organized Reserve, which will give you full details. It is requested that you read it carefully.
- The inclosed application should be prepared in triplicate, each copy being completed, signed and returned in the attached official envelope. If appointed, you will not be ordered to active duty without your consent except in the event of national emergency.
- The Officers' Reserve Corps has proven its worth. This essential component of the Army of the United States will be retained and enlarged. To accomplish this it is necessary to have the cooperation of each of you who played such important parts in our military successes.
- 4. It is hoped that the War Department will receive your application in the near future.
